A. CONTENTS

2 hoops, 1 bag of colour beads, 1 bag of glow-in-the-dark beads, 3 feathers, 6 spools of string, 1 glue pack and detailed instructions. (A pair of scissor is needed but not included. Adult supervision is required when using scissors.)

B. WRAPPING THE HOOPS 1 2 3 3 4 9 4 9 4 2

The Large Hoop

- 1. Start with the large hoop. Choose a coloured string, tie a knot through the hole on the top of the hoop. Wind the string around the hoop. There are some specially designed slots along the hoop that act as a guide reference.
- 2. Continue to wind the string tightly until the 3rd slot. Add some glue to the slot and tie a knot to secure it. Cut the excess string and keep it for the mini hoop.
- 3. Repeat the process with a different coloured string. Tie it to the hoop with a knot and add some glue to secure the string in place as you start winding the new colour. Continue to wind until the 6th slot and cut the excess. Complete the remaining hoop with the other strings, changing to a new colour at slots 9 and 12, each time securing the end with a knot and some glue.



4. Use the same techniques as shown in steps 1 to 3 to complete the mini hoop. Change to a different coloured string at slots 2, 4, 7 and 9.

C. WEAVING THE NETS 1 2 3

The Large Hoop


- 1. Take out the silver string and cut out lengths of 125cm and 75cm for making the net of mini hoop and the accessories in the later sessions. Use the leftover to tie a double knot at one of the slots on the large hoop, and slowly wrap the string around every slot. Feel free to pull and tighten the string to the desired effect as shown in the diagram.
- 2. Continue making loops until you reach the beginning.
- 3. You can now move on to the second row. Repeat the same weaving techniques, but instead of wrapping the sting around the hoop, you will wrap around the middle of each loop you made in step 2.



4. You can add a bead whenever you want. If you want to follow the design shown on the packaging, you can thread a bead on alternate loops in the 4th row. Continue weaving the net in the same way until you achieved the desired pattern. Secure the end of the string with a double knot.

The Mini Hoop

5. Go back to the 125-cm silver string you cut in Step 1 and start weaving the net for the mini hoop. This time you can design your own pattern. You may thread the beads on alternate loops while weaving. Secure the end of the string with a double knot.



- 1. Take out the 75-cm silver string you cut in step C1. Cut the silver string into 5 equal lengths. Take out one length to connect the two hoops by tying a knot at both hoops. Make the silver string shorter if you think it is too long. Take out another length and tie a knot through the hole on top of the big hoop, so you can hang it afterwards.
- 2. Tie the remaining silver strings to the bottom of the large hoop and the mini hoop.
- 3. Add two beads and a feather to each of the string. Thread two beads into the string and tie a knot at the end. Fold the end of the feather into half, add some glue and insert it into the hole of the beads. Your dream catcher is ready to hang!
- 4. Expose the dream catcher to a light source for a while. Turn off the light and watch it glow in the dark!
